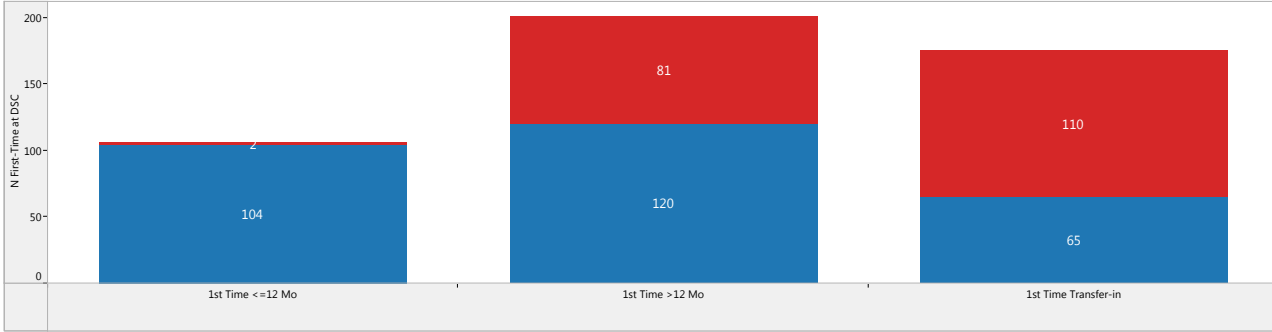

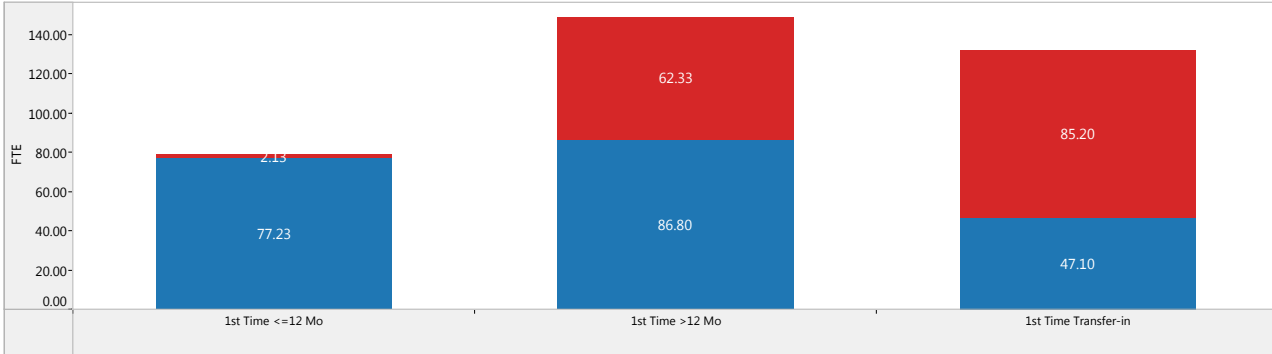
First-Time This Semester

Entering First-time Degree Seeking Undergraduates and Transfer-in's by Degree Type



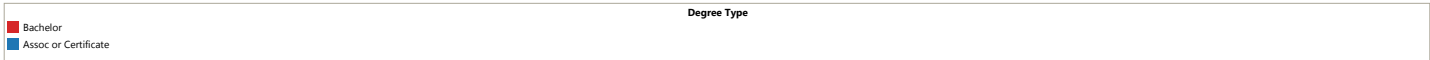
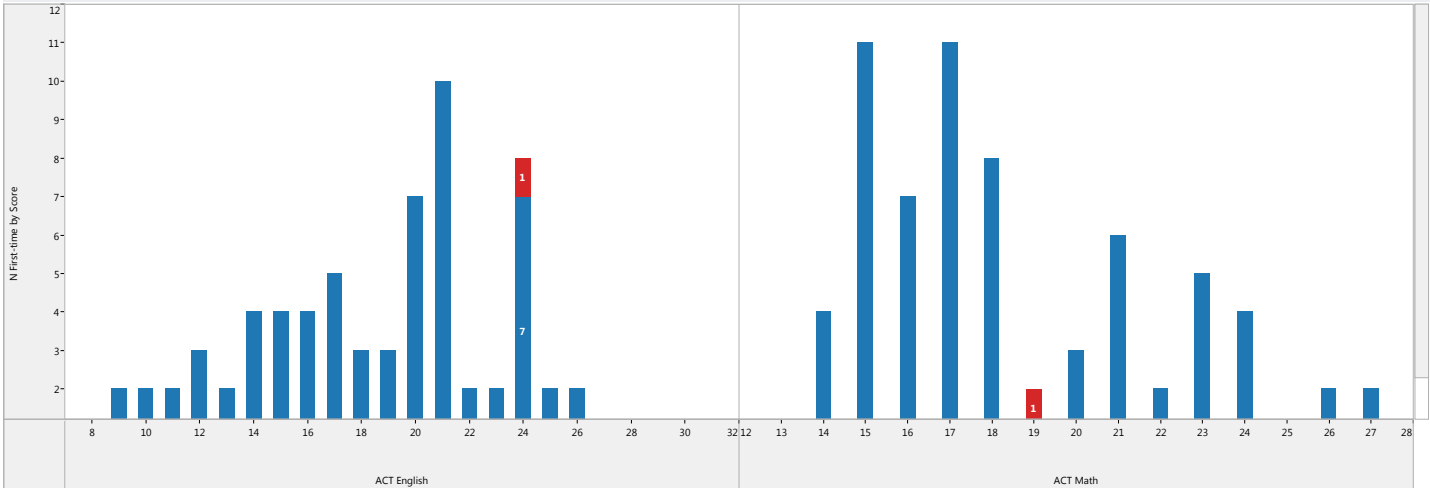

ACT English and Math Scores of First-time Undergraduates Directly from HS

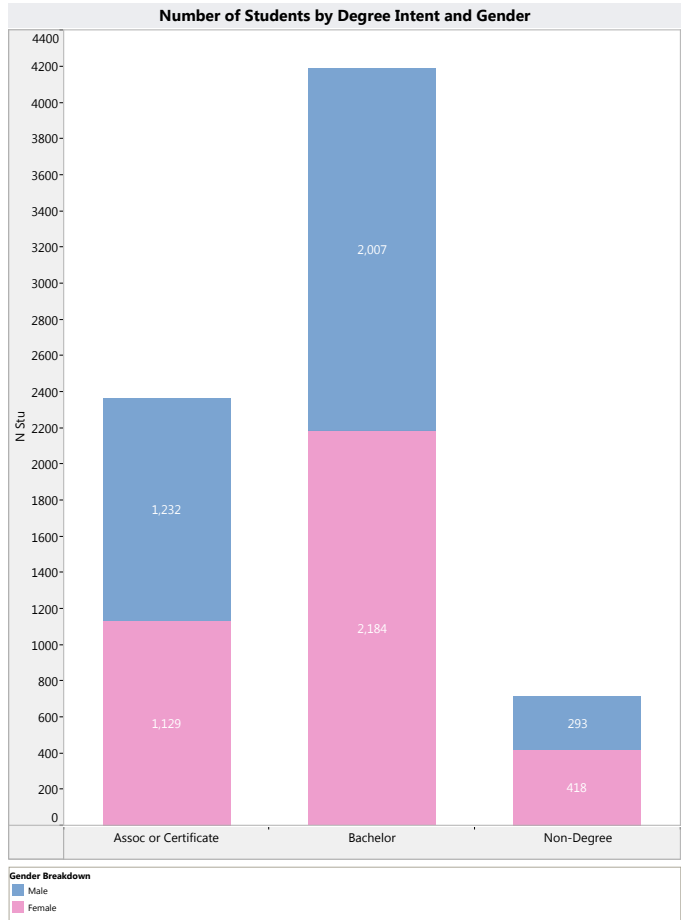

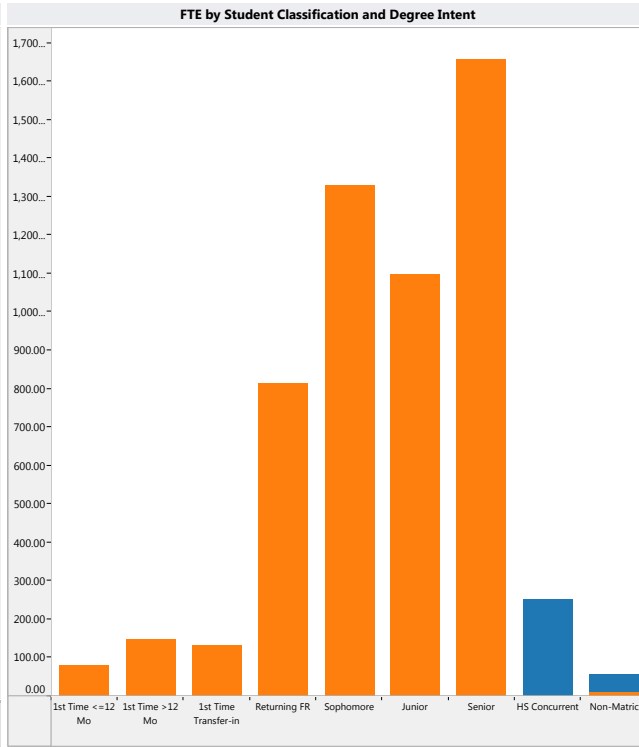
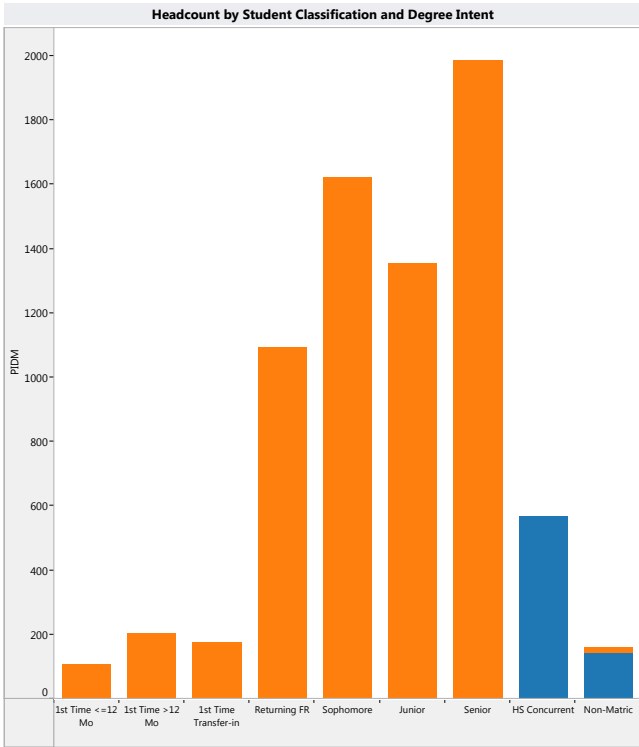
