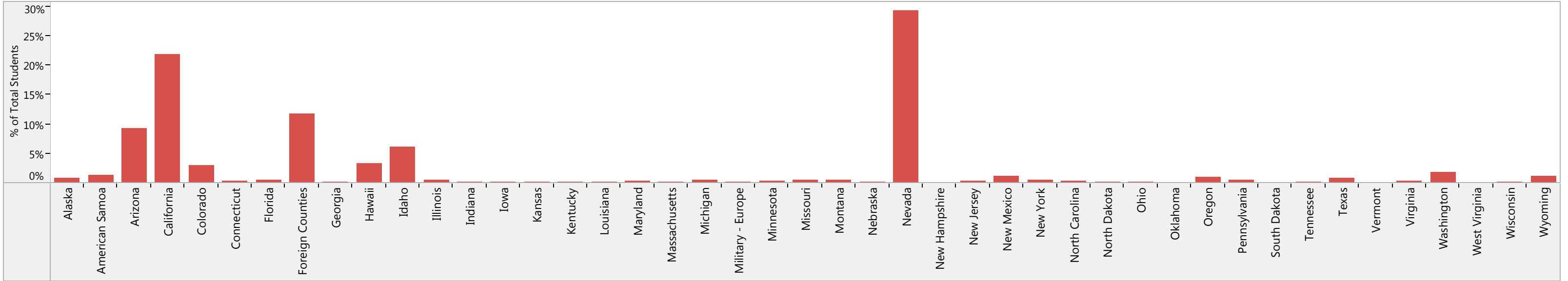

Percent Attending From Outside Utah

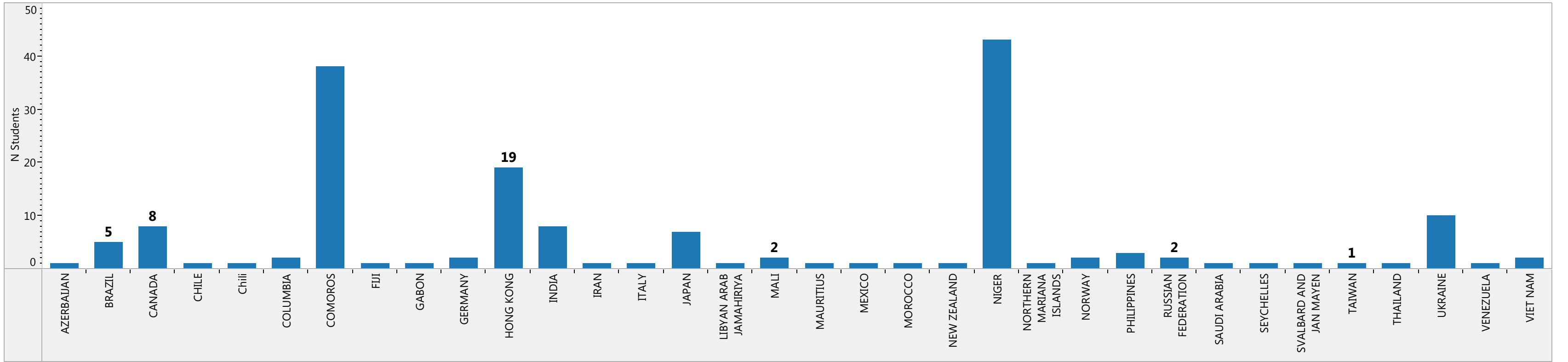

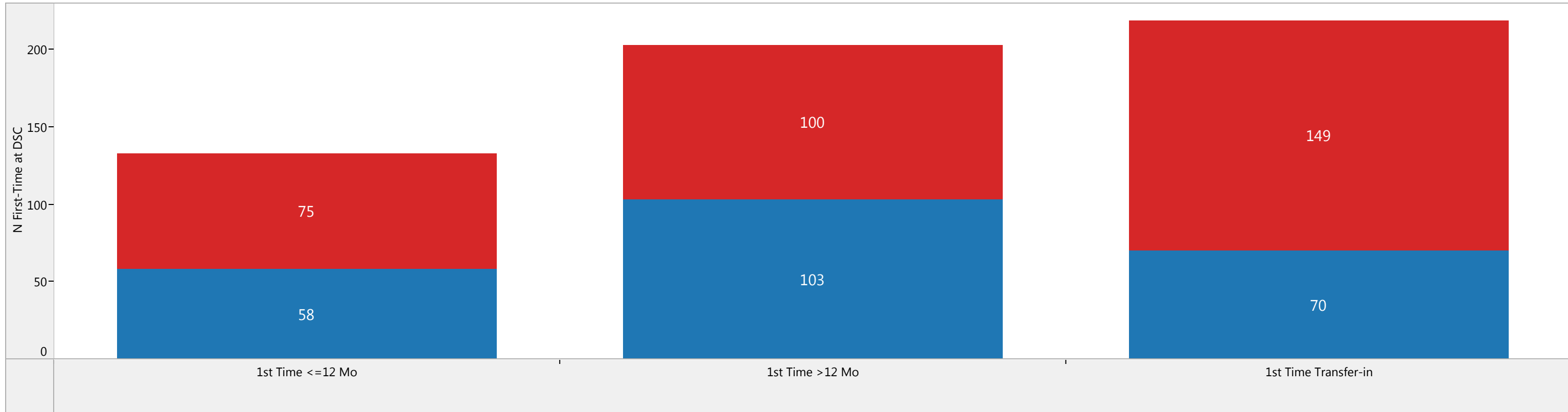

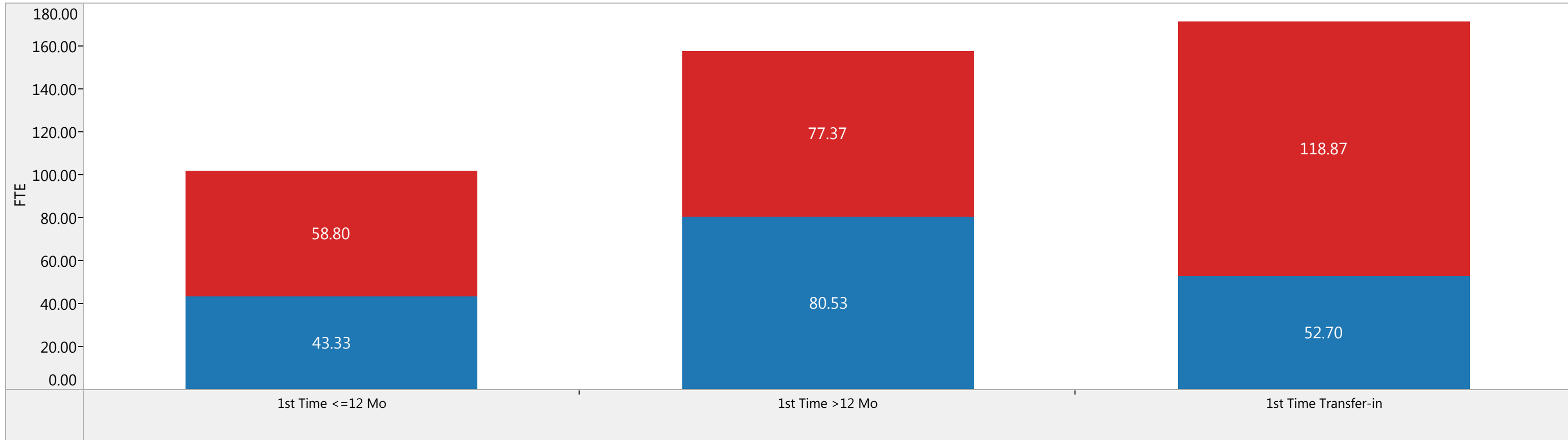

**FTE of First-time Degree Seeking Undergrads and Transfer-in's by Degree Type**

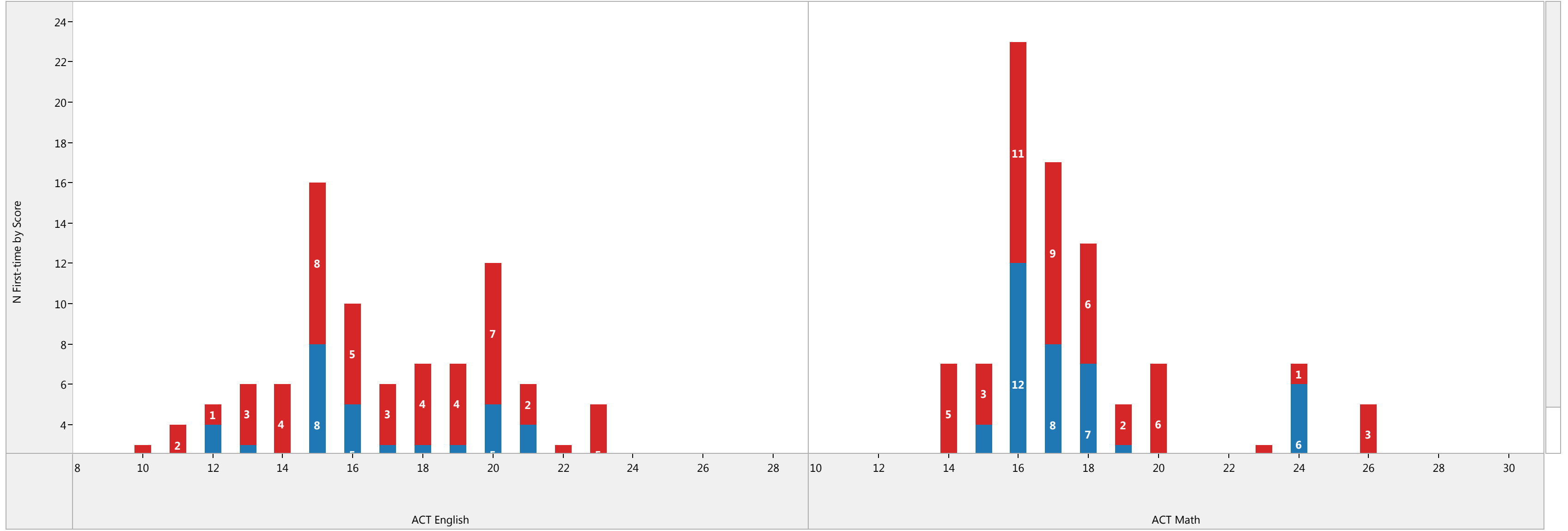

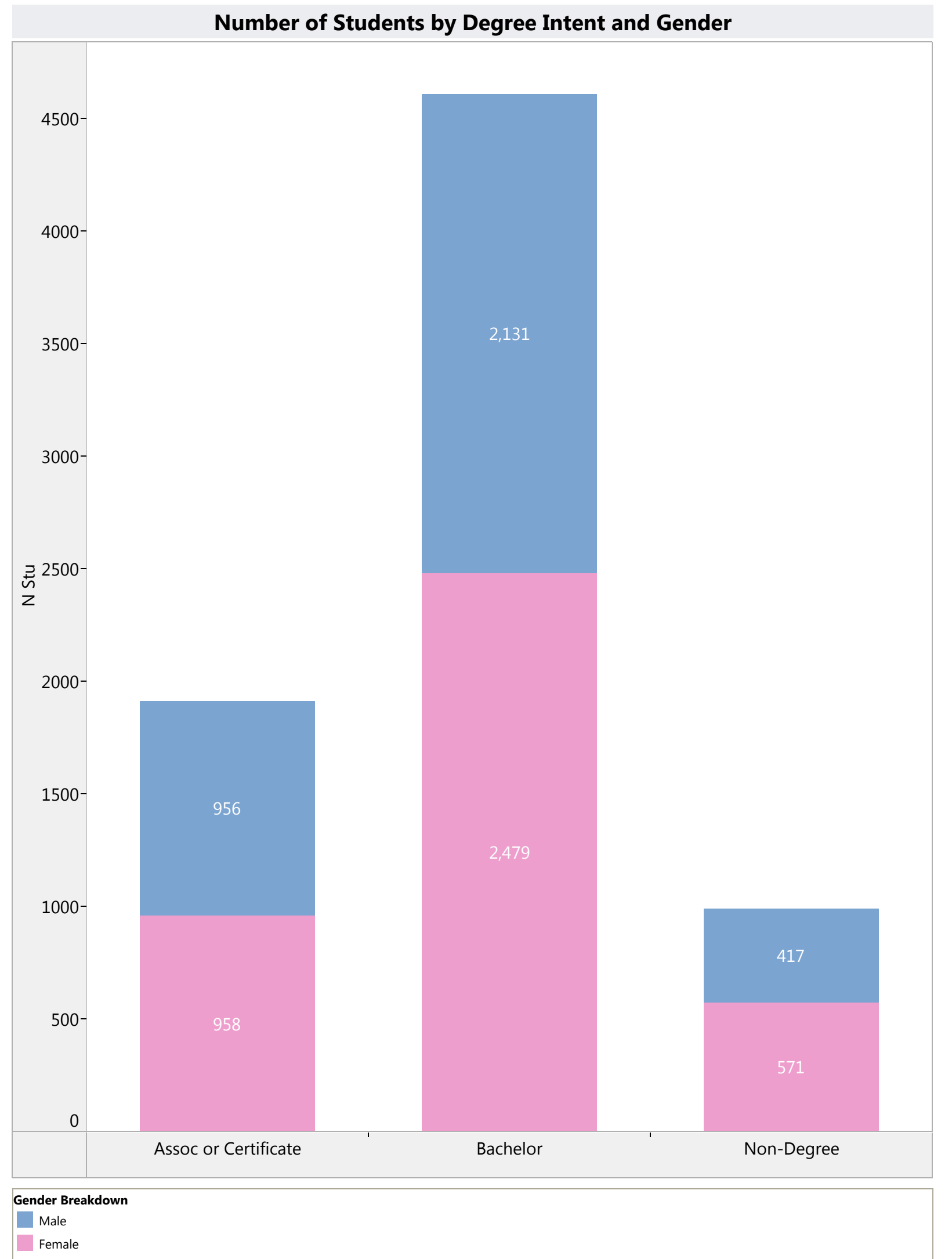

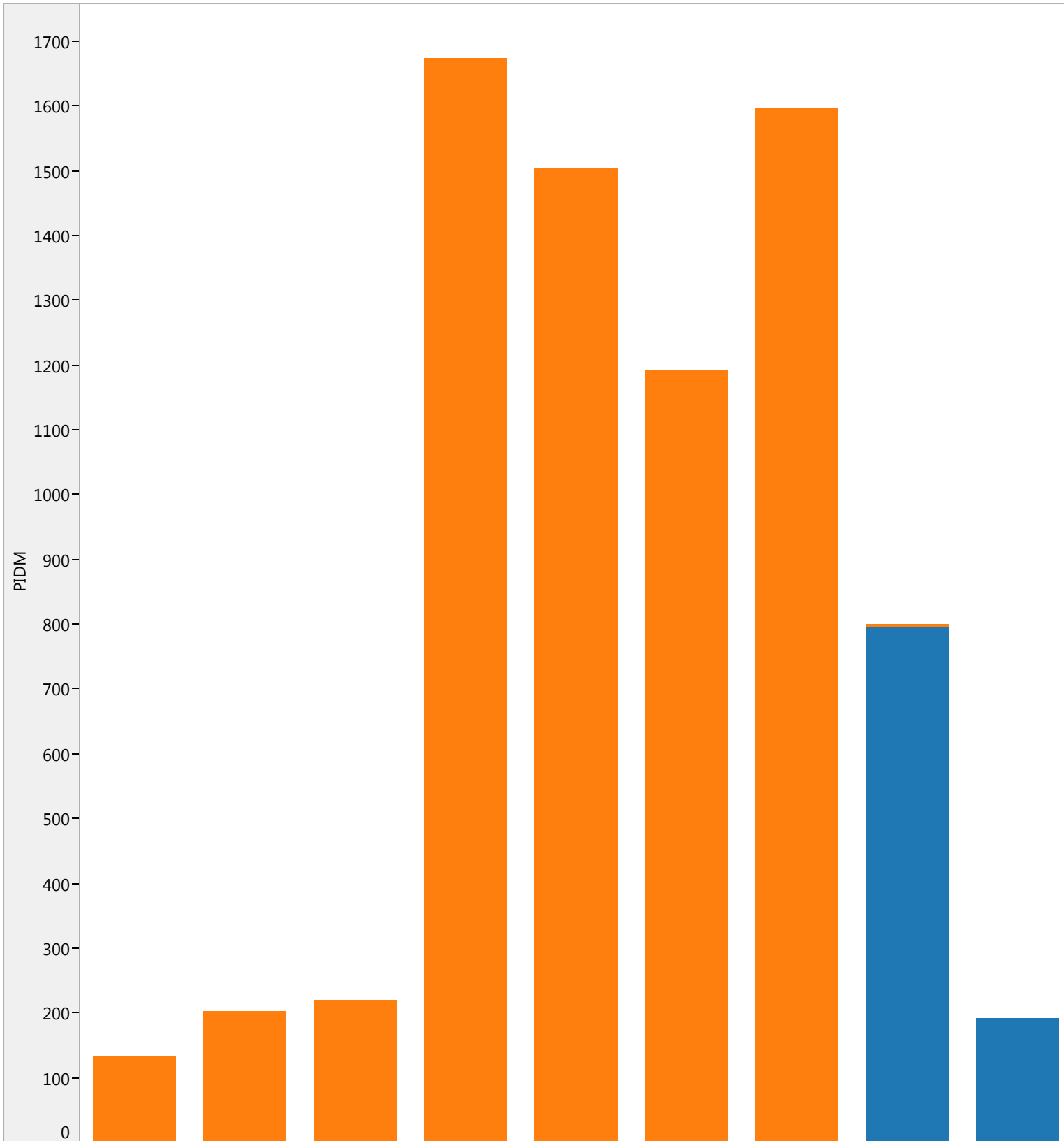

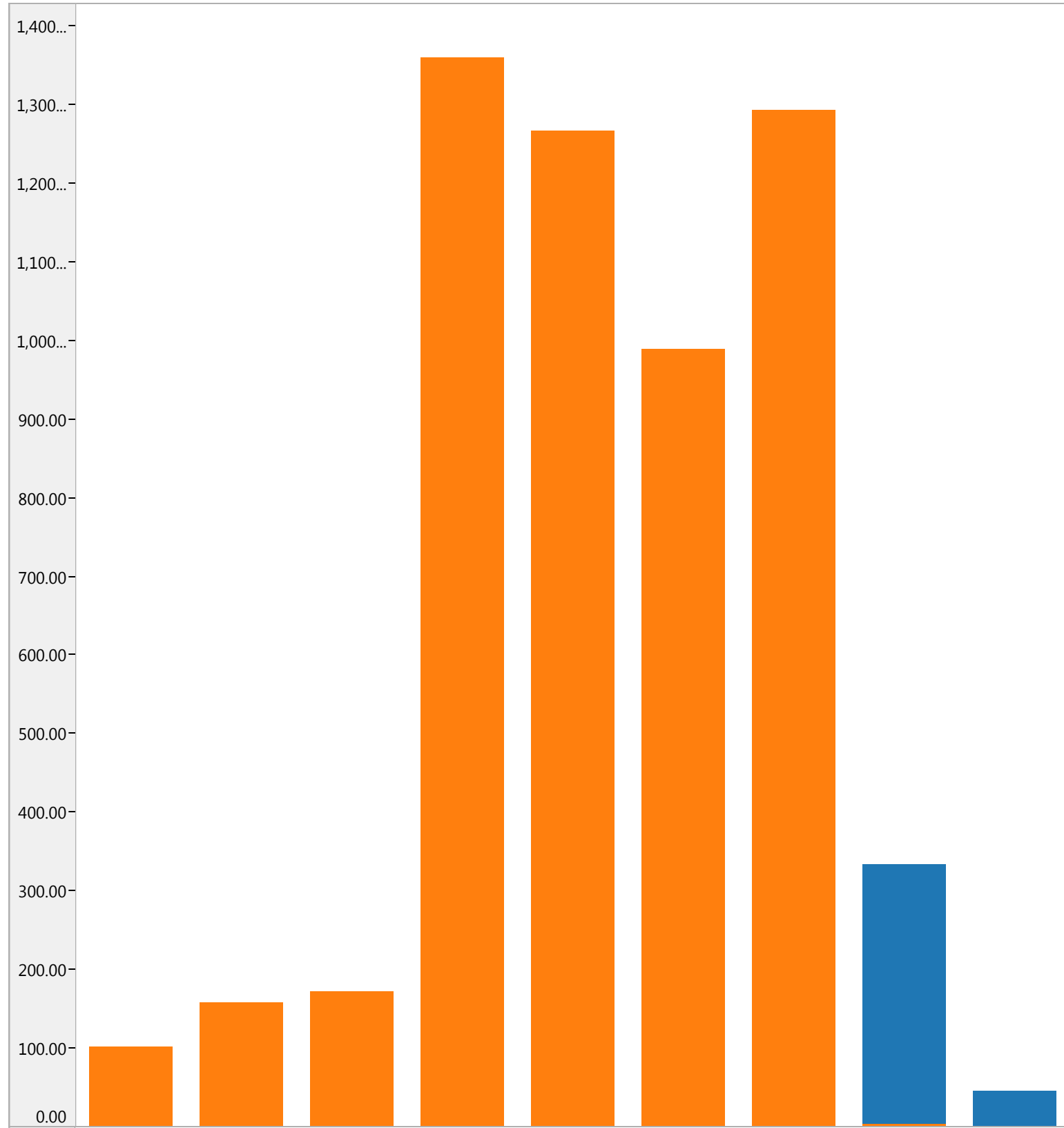
